CLASS 1a - Senior British Novice Championship - First Round

#### CLASS 1b - Senior 90cm Open

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Club Members are NOT eligible.

British Novice Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. Club Members are NOT eligible. a) For horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 125 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 316.6.b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2021 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of four years or under in the same calendar year as the Senior British Novice Championship Final - in accordance with Rule 316.6. Rule 102.16, British Showjumping Hind Boot rule for Boots / Leg Protection applies to this class. Qualifies for: Senior British Novice Championship - Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May - 30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horses which jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four Senior British Novice Championship - First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the Senior British Novice Championship - Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification. If combined with an open: In Category 1 Shows and in the event of 30 starters or more the Open and the British Novice section will be split with two sets of prize money awarded. In Category 2 Shows the sections must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6 Club Members are NOT eligible.

Rule 314. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only.

Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. Club Members are NOT eligible. a) For horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 225 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 314.6.b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2020 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of five years or under in the same calendar year as the Senior Discovery Championship Final - in accordance with Rule 314.6. Qualifies for: Nupafeed Supplements Discovery Championship - Second Round. Rule 102.16, British Showjumping Hind Boot rule for Boots / Leg Protection applies to this class. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horses that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four First Round

competitions held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the Senior Discovery Championship - Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go into the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification. If combined with an open: In Category 1 Shows and in the event of 30 starters or more the Open and the Discovery section will be split with two sets of prize money awarded.

In Category 2 Shows the sections must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters. PRIZES: 1ST: £30.00, 2ND: £20.00, 3RD: £19.00, 4TH: £19.00, 5TH: £19.00,

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

• Newcomers:(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 375 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 312.6 (b) For all horses born on or after 1st January 2019, irrespective of Points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of six years or under in the same calendar year as the Senior Newcomers Championship Final - in accordance with Rule 312.6. Four double clears will qualify for the Senior Newcomers Championship - Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st May to 30th April (subject to revision). If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money. • 1.10m Open: For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

• Foxhunter:(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 700 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 310.6(b) For all registered horses born on or after 1 January 2018, irrespective of points. Horses will be eligible for double clear qualification to attend second rounds providing they reach the age of seven years or under in the same calendar year as the Senior Foxhunter Final - in accordance with rule 310.6 Four double clears will qualify. Four double clears will qualify for the Senior Foxhunter Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st May to 30th April(subject to revision). Rule 102.16 British Showjumping hind boot rule for boots/leg protection applies in this class. Those horses that have qualified for the Senior Foxhunter Championship in 2024 are not eligible for gualification to the 2025 Championship. If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money. 1.20m Open: For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Open to registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate and Junior Members. Club Members are NOT eligible. Qualifies for: The British Showjumping National Championships. Qualifying period: 1st July-30th June. Numbers to qualify: Two double clears to qualify to the final. Double clear qualifications will not be obtained from one round competitions (e.g. Table A4 or Table A (1 Round)

For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. Club Members are NOT eligible. Qualifies for: National 1.40m Championship at the British Showjumping National Championships. Qualifying period: 1st July - 30th June Numbers to qualify: Two double clears to qualify to the final. Also, any two double clears from any International Trial or Area Trial or classes 1.40m or above in the qualifying period will qualify for the Final. Double clear qualifications will not be obtained from one round competitions (e.g. Table A4 or Table A (1 Round) FEI tack and boot rules apply. Padded Baton, Spurs must comply to national rules 101.9 & 102.9. Standing martingales are permitted in line with rule 102.3.

In the event of any rider travelling to a show on their own, details of an emergency contact should be left with the secretary in case of an accident.

Cars / Lorries are parked in car park at owners own risk

Please only pick up your droppings in the warm-up arena if safe to do so and placed in the bins provided.

Judges decision is FINAL; conduct must not be offensive to any show official.

Hard hats to current BS VG1, PAS 015 or SEI ASTM F1163 04a Onwards, SNELL E2001 AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards must be worn & correctly secured whilst mounted.

No competitor / rider shall allow a stallion for which they are responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure competitors, officials or other members of the public are not put at risk of injury, Stallions must display a ribbon in the tail and be lead from the bit at all times.

Once classes have been entered, Refunds will only be given, Less a £5 admin charge, if a valid Vet or Doctors Certificate is supplied.

Any person who fails to comply with these terms & conditions will be liable to forfeit their fees & expulsion from site. From Colchester: leave Colchester on the A120 towards Braintree turn right on the roundabout to join the A131 towards Halstead/Sudbury, next roundabout turn left onto the B1053 Broad Rd, turn right at second mini roundabout into Church Lane (by Braintree College) continue on until the road name changes into Church Street, go over bridge then turn left onto the Bovingdon Road, keep on this road till you come to a S bend (left & right corner) go downhill then turn left at industrial access sign into Codham Park Drive. N: 51° 55.832', E: 0° 31.813'

From Halstead/Gosfield: Turn off A1017 Hedingham/Braintree Road at Oak tree in Gosfield (Nr Kings Head Pub) into Church Road, follow onto Park Hall Road, turn left at junction on entering Beazley End, drop down hill and turn right at industrial access sign into Codham Park Drive. N: 51° 55.832', E: 0° 31.813'

From Chelmsford & M11: Please avoid the town centre by taking the A120 bypass towards Halstead/Sudbury A131, next roundabout turn left onto the B1053 Broad Rd, turn right at second mini roundabout into Church Lane (by Braintree College) continue on until the road name changes into Church Street, go over bridge then turn left onto the Bovingdon Road, keep on this road till you come to a S bend (left & right corner) go downhill then turn left at industrial access sign into Codham Park Drive. N: 51° 55.832', E: 0° 31.813'
